SALON D'AUTOMNE

In 1667 following the lead of the Italians' art establishment, Louis XIV began a tradition in France of Fall Salons. In these salons, French artists showed their works. It gave new prestige to art that became an annual event by 1737. The works of members of the ACADEMIE ROYALE DE PEINTURE ET DE SCULPTURE were exhibited in the room in the Louvre called the SALON D' APPOLLON, from which name "SALON" is derived.

A Spring Salon has been offered in Springville for some years. Logan Fine Art Gallery is offering a Salon of its own, for the twelfth year, open to all interested in presenting their art in Cache Valley.

Artists may submit up to two works (painting, drawing, printmaking, or sculpture) with an entrance fee of \$18.00 per entry. Artists's work must be framed appropriately. Art not accepted may be picked up after the exhibition opens (starting November 6).

The Fall Salon is both to draw artists and their art to Cache Valley to be seen, but also to build a patron anticipation in Logan to buy new art as it is made available each year.

The salon presentation will run through December and part of January to take advantage of the Christmas season. Art sells best in Logan in the \$500 to \$5,000 range, but all art entered will be eligible for prize money whether for sale or not.

SHIPPING AGREEMENT: Logan Fine Art will not insure artwork in transit or pay for artwork shipping.

RELEASE AGREEMENT: The undersigned recognizes that there are risks attached to the management and care of all the artwork. Therefore, in consideration of submitting the artwork for exhibition, the undersigned does release and hold harmless Logan Fine Art from assumption of liability for any claim for "high risk" artwork or any claim above or beyond current fair market value of the artwork.
